

Together in Mission: A Monthly Ministry Moment from Pastor Walt

Grace and peace to you in the name of Jesus Christ!

Along with the seasons of Advent and Christmas, December brings a close to our calendar year. With the passing of another year, it is good to take time to reflect upon life's joys and sorrows, our families, and the way that God's grace has touched our lives.

2022 was a year of transitions and new beginnings. I am grateful for the Spirit's mysterious workings that brought us together in ministry. I share additional thanks for the opportunity to work with a dedicated staff, council, and other leaders at CVLC. Already, we are doing amazing things, and I look forward to what God has in store for us in the future.

My *Listening Post* conversations continue to be fruitful. I've learned much from these one-on-one chats. Currently, I am a third of the way towards the goal of a hundred conversations by February. My notebook is full of hopes, dreams, and helpful suggestions. As I mentioned in these listening sessions, I intend to use these conversations along with CVLC's Strategic Plan, completed a while ago, to develop some directions for us to take as we write the next chapter of CVLC's history together.

Meanwhile, with limited success, I have tried not to make any significant changes to our worship and ministries until I've had enough time to listen and learn what is important to this congregation. The changes I have made are in the area of adjustments to make things run a little smoother or respond to particular concerns that have arisen. From an outsider's perspective, I have raised some operational questions and suggested alternative ways of doing things that CVLC's staff and council embraced. I am grateful for the collaboration that has characterized our first 100 days in ministry together.

Since September, we have expanded the weekly email into a weekly newsletter. This electronic communication provides valuable and timely information about what is going on in our community and offers opportunities for engagement. The office staff meets together on Tuesday to make sure that all that you need to know is in the weekly email/newsletter. This takes a fair bit of work, but we are committed to providing you with the latest.

With a weekly newsletter in place, the question arose as to whether we still needed a monthly version. For the most part, these communications contained the same information in slightly different formats. The staff and I took a long hard look at these communication pieces and concluded that it no longer made sense to continue with the monthly newsletter. We can work the few items that were unique to the monthly newsletter (like the list of birthdays and messages from music and council) into the publication schedule of the weekly email.

And so, for the time being, this will be the final monthly newsletter. We will continue with a slightly expanded weekly email that uses our website more. Starting in January, we will make a print version of the weekly newsletter available for folks who choose not to receive the information electronically.

As with all alterations and changes, I am open to conversations, feedback, and suggestions. Please reach out to me, and we can set up a time to talk things through. Together we can make things better, run more efficient, and free up more resources for the work of Christ's church.

Blessings to you and your family during these days of Advent and the forthcoming Christmas holiday. I look forward to celebrating Christ's birth among us with you.

Music Notes by Joyce Reitz, Director of Music









Thank you, thank you, thank you to all of our talented crafters who generously donated items to the Craft Bazaar! You are all so amazing!



Online Giving

We have had a number of questions about opportunities to continue contributing to CVLC when we don't attend services. One option is to mail your checks to the church (we have a secure mailbox) **15600 Tamiami Trail N., Naples, FL 34110**. Another option is to use our E-Giving program as follows:

- Go to the CVLC website (www.christusvictorfl.org).
- Click on "Give" (upper right)
- Under "Two Ways to Enroll" click on "online"
- Then indicate the amount you wish to contribute
- Choose the frequency using the drop-down
- Create your Online Profile so that you can easily return to your online account
- Click on "Continue" at bottom left and follow the prompts.

You have the option of having the contributions come directly from your checking account (our preference), or you can make contributions via credit card (this option deducts at least 2.5% from your contribution before it gets to us).
